

## Pietro Celi speaker CV



Pietro Celi is a Senior Scientist at DSM Nutritional Products where he is Project Director for the Gut Health Platform (CRP); he also provides scientific support to the Global R&D Ruminant and Eubiotic teams. After graduating in Veterinary Medicine at the University of Bari (Italy) he worked for 12 months in a small animal practice; he then moved to Perth, Western Australia, to complete a PhD in animal science (University of Western Australia). In 2000 he took a lectureship position at the University of Basilicata (Potenza, Italy) and in 2005 he joined the University of Sydney as Senior Lecturer in Ruminant Health and Production at the Faculty of Veterinary Science where he also completed a Graduate Certificate in Higher Education. He has been involved in studies into animal physiology for a number of years and during this time he has worked on a variety of livestock species. Dr Celi's core expertise is the study of the interactions between nutrition, metabolism and reproduction in domestic animals with particular interest in the study of oxidative stress biomarkers. He maintains a Senior Research Fellow at the University of Melbourne where he is collaborating on a Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry funded project investigating nutritional strategies to improve resilience against heat stress in livestock. Dr Celi has published 81 peer reviewed journal papers, 3 book chapters and 112 conference papers. He is member of the Editorial Board for the following international journals: Immunopharmacology and Immunotoxicology, Frontiers in Veterinary Science and Journal of Dairy Research.
