He has dedicated his research on issues of quality of food of animal origin and the processing and storage of the same. currently he is the president of Dipartimento Qualità Agroalimentare (Agri-Food Certification Agency) is a certification company of the best Italian agri-food products. It was awarded with Presidential Decree "A gold medal which Meritorious Science, Culture and Art". The Academy of Sciences called the XL awarded him the "Domenico Marotta" award (1987).
